STANDARD INSPECTION AGREEMENT

THIS IS INTENDED TO BE A LEGALLY BINDING CONTRACT. PLEASE READ IT CAREFULLY

SCOPE OF THE INSPECTION: The real estate inspection to be performed for Client is a non-invasive physical examination, performed for the fee set forth below, designed to identify material defects in the systems, structures, and components of the above-referenced primary building and its associated primary parking structure as they exist at the time of the inspection. A material defect is a condition that significantly affects the value, desirability, habitability or safety of the building. Style or aesthetics shall not be considered in determining whether a specific system, structure, or component is defective. The inspection shall be limited to those specific systems, structures, and components that are present and visually accessible. Components and systems shall be operated with normal user controls only and as conditions permit.

The inspection will be performed in accordance with the Standards of Practice of the California Real Estate Inspection Association ("CREIA") in effect at the time of this inspection. A copy of the CREIA Standards is available upon request. This inspection is not intended to be technically exhaustive. The home inspector will never be able to predict every repair or maintenance item encountered while owning a house.

Purchasing a home brings risk. An inspection cannot eliminate this risk. An inspection does not constitute an insurance policy.

It gives you an overall impression of the house and discloses any immediate major repairs of the items found, at that time during and or observed during the inspection. Client agrees to read the entire inspection report when it is received and shall promptly call the Inspector with any questions or concerns client may have regarding the real estate inspection or the inspection report.

LIMITATIONS, EXCEPTIONS AND EXCLUSIONS: Excluded from this real estate inspection is any system, structure, or component of the building which is inaccessible, concealed from view, or cannot be inspected due to circumstances beyond the control of Inspector, or which Client has agreed is not to be inspected. The following are excluded from the scope of this real estate inspection unless specifically agreed otherwise between Inspector and Client:

- Determining compliance with installation guidelines, manufacturers' specifications, building codes, ordinances, regulations, covenants, or other restrictions, including local interpretations thereof.
- Obtaining or reviewing information from any third-parties including, but not limited to: government agencies (such as permits), component or system manufacturers (including product defects, recalls or similar notices), contractors, managers, sellers, occupants, neighbors, consultants, homeowner or similar associations, attorneys, agents or brokers.
- Geotechnical, engineering, structural, architectural, geological, hydrological, land surveying or soils-related examinations.
- Examination of conditions related to animals, rodents, insects, wood-destroying insects, organisms, mold, and mildew or the damage caused thereby.
- Certain factors relating to any systems, structures, or components of the building, including, but not limited to: adequacy, efficiency, durability or remaining useful life, costs to repair, replace or operate, fair market value, marketability, quality, or advisability of purchase.
- Environmental hazards or conditions, including, but not limited to, toxic, reactive, combustible, corrosive contaminants, wildfire, geologic or flood.
- Dismantling of any system, structure, or component, or perform any intrusive or destructive examination, test or analysis.
- Examining or evaluating fire-resistive qualities of any system, structure or component of the building.
- Systems, structures, or components of the building which are not permanently installed.

- Systems, structures, or components not specifically identified in the written inspection report.
- Common areas, or systems, structures, or components hereof, including, but not limited to, those of a common interest development as defined in California Civil Code section 1351, et seq.
- Examining or evaluating the acoustical or other nuisance characteristics of any system, structure, or component of a building, complex, adjoining properties, or neighborhood.
- Operating or evaluating low voltage electrical, antennas, security systems, cable or satellite television, telephone, remote controls, radio controls, timers, intercoms, computers, photo-electric, motion sensing, or other such similar non-primary electrical power devices, components, or systems.
- Examining or operating any sewage disposal system or component including, but not limited to: septic tanks and/or any underground system or portion thereof, or ejector pumps for rain or waste.

Services for inspecting or evaluating the excluded items listed above may be available from Inspector for an additional fee or from specialists qualified to inspect or evaluate a particular category or item.

Inspector is a home inspection generalist and is not acting as an expert in any craft or trade. The inspection report may contain recommendations for further evaluation by an individual other than Inspector herein who is qualified as an expert or specialist. If Inspector recommends consulting other specialized experts, Client agrees to do so at their own expense.

It is Client's duty and obligation to exercise reasonable care to protect himself or herself regarding the condition of the subject property, including those facts which are known to or within the diligent attention and observation of Client.

SEVERABILITY: Should any provision of this contract be held by a court of competent jurisdiction to be either invalid or unenforceable, the remaining provisions of this contract shall remain in full force and effect, unimpaired by the courts' holding.

ARBITRATION: Any dispute concerning the interpretation of this Agreement or arising from this inspection and report, except one for inspection fee payment, shall be resolved between the parties by BINDING ARBITRATION conducted in accordance with the rules of the American Arbitration Association except that the parties shall select an arbitrator who is familiar with the home inspection industry or

The parties hereto shall be entitled to all discovery rights and legal motions as provided in the California Code of Civil Procedure. The arbitrator shall apply the substantive and procedural laws of the State of California to all issues submitted in the arbitration proceeding. The award of the arbitrator shall be final, and a judgment may be entered on it by any court having jurisdiction.

GENERAL PROVISIONS: This inspection contract, the real estate inspection, and the inspection report do not constitute a home warranty, guarantee, or insurance policy of any kind whatsoever. This agreement constitutes the entire integrated agreement between the parties hereto pertaining to the subject matter hereof, and may be modified only by a written agreement signed by all of the parties hereto. No oral agreements, understandings, or representations shall change, modify, or amend any part of this agreement.

Note: The presence of certain mold and mold spores can cause mild to severe health effects in humans and can deteriorate the building materials in the dwelling resulting in structural damage. Health effects include, but are not limited to: asthma, allergy symptoms, watery eyes, sneezing, wheezing, difficulty breathing, sinus congestion, blurry vision, sore throat, dry cough, aches and pains, skin irritation, bleeding of the lungs, headaches, memory loss and fever. As humans vary greatly in their chemical make-up, so does the individual's reaction to mold exposure. For some people, a small number of mold spores can cause ill effects. In others it may take a longer exposure.

Possible mold growth was discovered and is visible in one or more areas of the home. It is recommended that the certain area(s) of the dwelling be sampled to determine the type(s) of mold present. The test performed is a swab test, which will be sent to **PRO-LAB™** for analysis to determine the types(s) of mold present at the time of sampling. Cost to provide this testing service is \$_____.

During the time of the home inspection a visible condition or visible mold growth was observed and exists. This may indicate that water intrusion has occurred, or is currently occurring. This condition is conducive to mold growth that could be present in areas not readily visible in the home. It is recommended that indoor and outdoor air sampling of the home be conducted, this will allow for the comparison and identity of the type(s) of mold present and also the concentrations of mold spores. All samples will be sent to **PRO-LAB™** to determine the type(s) of mold present at the time of sampling. The cost to provide this testing service is \$_____.

During the time of the home inspection, no visible conditions or signs which indicate mold growth were observed. However, it still may be possible that mold exists in the home. As a precaution it is recommended that a carpet sample be taken which will provide data to determine if mold spores are present, and if so, what type(s) are present. All samples will be sent to **PRO-LAB™** to determine the type(s) of mold present at the time of sampling. The cost to provide this testing service is \$_____.

Please be aware that the tests performed are only an indication of the actual conditions at the time the sampling has occurred. As conditions can possibly change over time, this is only an indication of the type of mold in the area tested at the time the test was taken. This is no guarantee that mold does not exist in other areas of the home, such as behind walls. You may wish to seek additional advice of a Certified Industrial Hygienist or a mold remediation specialist for further consultation.
